Why should you attend this workshop?

What tests and protocols are to be used for students with disabilities? Schools should use the Brockport Fitness Test methodologies for any student with disabilities whose Individualized Education Program (IEP) identifies the FitnessGram as not appropriate. If schools want more detail on adapted fitness testing, including instructional videos, districts may wish to purchase the Brockport Fitness Test Manual. A new section (page 16 #5) has been added to the IEP form to identify students being tested using Brockport.

Requirement of the Fitness Testing Law: Each district will maintain evidence of individual school personnel's successful completion of the training and make it available to the ISBE upon request.

Do you know how to select tests for your students with disabilities, do you know how to give the Brockport assessments, and do you know how to write the Brockport into an IEP? Have you completed training and does your school district have it on record? If not this is the workshop for you!
