Scholarship Application Form

Please include the following items in your packet for the IAHPERD scholarship.

1. Five copies of a short cover letter of introduction which includes your IAHPERD membership number – this number may be acquired from the IAHPERD Executive Director at 217-245-6413 or by emailing iahperd@mchsi.com.
2. Five copies of a typed resume' including professional accomplishments, honors, voluntary professional development activities, certifications received, service in professional organizations, extra-curricular activities, community program involvement, research projects, and presentations you may have participated in during the past two years. Please include your summer and/or early fall address, phone number and email address, College/University and academic department attending. Department Chairperson's name and contact information, your academic major and minor, and your expected date of graduation.
3. Five copies of a two page typed application essay addressing the following two questions:
 - A. Why did you choose to go into the field of health, physical education, recreation or dance?
 - B. Where do you see yourself professionally in the next five years?
4. One copy of an official College/University transcript.
5. Two letters of recommendations in individually sealed envelopes.

Scholarship Eligibility

In order to be eligible for an IAHPERD scholarship, one must:

1. Be a full-time undergraduate student, majoring in the area of health, physical education, recreation, and/or dance. This includes a major referred to by other titles, such as Kinesiology, Human Performance, Sports Administration, Athletic Training, etc.
2. Be a full-time undergraduate student during the fall semester in which the scholarship is awarded.
3. Be a student member of IAHPERD since December 1 of the year previous to the year the scholarship is awarded.
4. Attend a college or university within the State of Illinois.

In order to be eligible for an IAHPERD scholarship, one may:

1. Have their home residence outside the State of Illinois.
2. Have previously earned a bachelor's degree in a different major, and is currently pursuing a bachelor's degree in an undergraduate program as stated above.
3. Have been a previous IAHPERD recipient, with a maximum of receiving a scholarship two times.
4. Be a recipient of the top scholarship award only one time.
