SUMMARY:
Amends the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code. Provides that the Department of Public Health has the power to make matching grants from the Heartsaver AED Fund to any forest preserve district, conservation district municipal recreation department to assist in purchasing Automated External Defibrillators. Provides that a forest preserve or conservation district, municipal recreation department, school or university must contribute 50% of the cost of the AED.

TITLE: Defibrillators and Physical Fitness Facilities
INTRODUCED: 02/15/2007

LOCATION: Chaptered
SUMMARY:
Amends the Physical Fitness Facility Medical Emergency Preparedness Act. Requires that outdoor, as well as indoor, physical fitness facilities have at least one automated external defibrillator (AED) on the premises. Includes a football stadium, soccer field, baseball diamond or similar facility. Exempts

any facility owned or operated by a park district, a forest preserve district or conservation district. Requires a trained AED user to be present. Includes gaming establishments.

SUMMARY:

Amends the Chicago School District Article of the School Code. Provides that the Chicago Board of Education shall require that schools provide recess for all students in kindergarten through grade 8. Provides that recess must be at least 10 minutes in length. Provides that if the principal determines that the weather is inclement, the principal shall direct that a recess be held indoors.

SUMMARY:

Amends the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code. Provides that the Department shall require an electrocardiogram (EKG) test as part of the health examinations that student athletes are required to undergo. Provides that there is no rule making authority. Provides that the requirement that an EKG test be part of a student athlete's health examination must be part of a pilot program that the Department of Public Health must establish.

Amends the Interscholastic Athletic Organization Act. Provides that no public elementary or public secondary school in this State nor any association or other entity that sponsors, regulates, or in any manner provides for interscholastic athletic, academic, or other form of competition among schools and students within this State may infringe upon or attempt to regulate in any manner the dissemination of news or the use of visual images by the news media.

Creates the Eldercise Fitness Website Act. Provides that, subject to appropriation, the Department of Public Health and the Department on Aging, in cooperation with the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness, shall create an Internet-based statewide fitness program to educate and involve older citizens and their families in physical activities, as well as to stress the importance of proper nutrition. Provides for no rule making authority.

TITLE: State Finance Act
INTRODUCED: 02/14/2008

SUMMARY:

Amends the State Finance Act, the Illinois Income Tax Act, and the Property Tax Code. Increases the income tax rates for individuals, trusts, and estates from 3% to 5% of the taxpayer's net income and increases the rate of income tax for corporations from 4.8% to 8% of the taxpayer's net income. Creates an income tax credit for families with incomes below certain levels. Creates the School District Property Tax Relief Fund.
